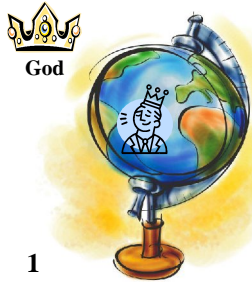


1. God is the only perfect, all-powerful, holy, and infinite being (no beginning or end)

- Their sin ended their communication with God and made them His enemies

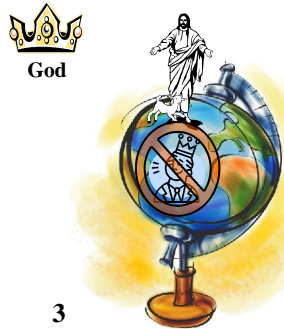

- He was the only man who could reverse the curse brought about by Adam, because He was the only perfect (sinless) man

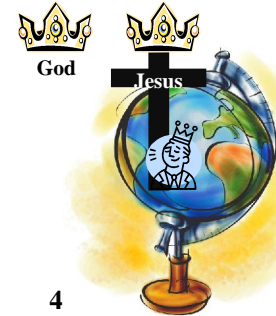

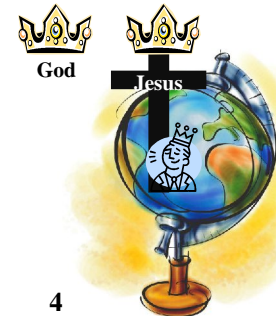

**What happens now?**

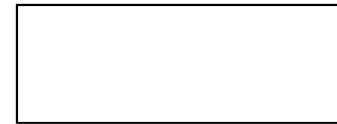
- If you have taken this step of faith, now you are feeling the joy of a new birth.

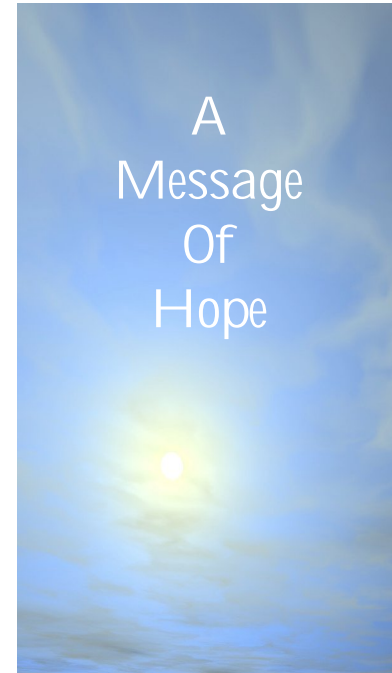
